1st Year Students – Spring Semester Schedule Options

Use the Math Placement Tool to determine your placement in calculus related sequences—including MATH 117, 118, 124, 125, and 126, the 1-credit pre-calculus course sequence—unless you have AP, IB, or college transfer credit for Calculus I. **There are three placement options:**

OPTION #1: Cleared to take MATH 155 or 160.

OPTION #2: Cleared to take MATH 117, 118, 124, 125 and/or 126.

OPTION #3: Cleared to take MATH 101.

OPTION #1 – Calculus Ready

Typical Scenario:

1. Math Placement Tool recommends MATH 155 or 160.
2. Composition Placement recommends CO 150.

GEOL 110, 120, 122, <u>or</u> 150	3-4 credits
MATH 155 <u>or</u> 160	4 credits

Essential To-Do's: Before January, spend some time reviewing your math text books from high school to reacquaint yourself with key terminology and concepts to start off on the right foot in Calculus I.

OPTION #2 – Pre-Calculus Ready

Typical Scenario:

1. Math Placement Tool recommends MATH 117 or other pre-calculus courses.
2. Composition Placement recommends CO 150.

CO 150	3 credits
GEOL 110, 120, 122 <u>or</u> 150	3-4 credits

OPTION #3 – MATH 101 Ready

Typical Scenario:

1. Math Placement Tool recommends MATH 101.
2. Comp Placement recommends CO 150.
